Based out of New York City, cellist Eric Eaton has established a diverse performance career. He regularly performs with many orchestras in the New York area including the New York Chamber players, Urban Players Chamber Orchestra, Orchestra Of The Bronx, New Haven Symphony Orchestra, and the Empire Chamber Orchestra. He has performed in many New York City venues such as Lincoln Center, Carnegie Hall, 54 Below, Mercury Lounge, Webster Hall, and Pacha.
