Solo and collaborative pianist, Grace Han made her orchestral debut at age 12 at Colburn's Zipper Hall performing the Mendelssohn Piano Concerto No. 1 in G minor with the Torrance Symphony Orchestra. Soon after that, Grace was the Grand Prize winner of the Korea Times Piano Competition and received first prize in several competitions such as the Southern California Bach Competition, South Bay State Competition, the Music Teacher's Association of California Piano Solo and Concerto Competition, and the NYIMC Young Musicians Competition.

She has performed in various venues in Los Angeles including the Steinway Piano Gallery, Yamaha Peninsula Music Center, Armstrong Theatre, and just recently at the Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall in New York City. She is also a teaching artist with the Bridge Arts Ensemble and maintains a private studio in New York City and New Jersey as well.

Ms. Han has studied with Dr. Louise Lepley and Dr. Solomon Mikowsky and has a Bachelor's Degree from the Manhattan School of Music. She is currently pursuing her Master's of Music Degree under the tutelage of Alexandre Moutouzkine.
